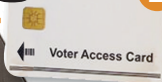

ELECTION DAY

- Polls are open today from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- To find out where you go to vote, call your county clerk's office.

1 Obtain voter access card from a poll worker and insert into the card port.



Screen can be adjusted to make text larger or to have more contrast for better readability.

2 High contrast

Adjust screen
The monitor screen is divided into three segments.

3 VOTING

John Doe

You pick a candidate or issue by touching the box on the left of the name or issue.

To undo or change your ballot simply retouch the box and your mark will be removed.

Write-in



Record write-in

To write in a candidate, select the write-in box; a keyboard will appear; type in the candidate's name on the screen and press the "record write-in" button.

PRESS the "NEXT" button to proceed to the following window.

CAST YOUR BALLOT

TOUCH "CAST YOUR BALLOT" WHEN DONE.

The machine will then review your voting choices on screen and you will be required to either "PRINT BALLOT" or "REJECT BALLOT" to make changes.

This completes the voting process and you return your voter access card to the poll worker.
