



CALVIN SHANE MYERS

- Charged with two counts of capital murder in the December 1994 stabbing death of his ex-girlfriend, 20-year-old Irene Francis Christensen, and her unborn son.
 - Pleaded guilty in February 1996 to one murder count in exchange for dismissal of the second charge.
 - Sentenced to life in prison with the possibility of parole, although the state parole board has recommended that he never be released.

ROGER MARTIN MACGUIRE

- Charged with two counts of capital murder in the January 2001 slaying of his 39-year-old ex-wife, Susan MacGuire, and her unborn child.
 - Prosecution is on hold pending a ruling from the Utah Supreme Court on whether a person can be charged with killing a fetus.

EARL LESTON BARNES

- Charged with capital murder in the Jan. 26 slaying of Garfield County sheriff's deputy David Jones.
 - Pleaded guilty to the murder charge earlier this year as part of a plea agreement that would spare his life; sentenced to life in prison without parole.

LEE ROY WOOD

- Charged with capital murder in the July 2001 slaying of Roosevelt Police Chief Cecil Gurr.
 - Pleaded guilty to the murder charge and one count of attempted homicide as part of a plea agreement that would spare his life.
 - Sentenced in September 2002 to life in prison without parole.

QUINN ROBERT MARTINEZ

- Charged with two counts of capital murder in the April 2000 shooting spree at Chevys Fresh Mex Restaurant.
- Pleaded guilty to the charges after prosecutors agreed not to seek the death penalty.
- Sentenced to two life terms without the possibility of parole.
