

# Using a roundabout

Although relatively new in the U.S., roundabouts have been used in Europe for years as a means to increase traffic flow and reduce accidents.

Most roundabouts employ three or more entries/exits.

There is no parking or pedestrian crossing on a roundabout.

- 1 The car yields to oncoming vehicle on the left. Roundabouts are ONE WAY only.

- 3 The car exits toward Tooele

- 2 The car merges into traffic, traveling past the Park City and Ogden exits

A diagram similar to the one at the right will appear on a sign at the intersection. The car is coming from Salt Lake and going to Tooele.
